

Ship Charles Coast of Peru Dec. 1838.

394. Friday 28th Strong trades and pleasant, headed to the N.E.
 at 8 A.M. kept off N.W. saw blackfish noon Lat 12-45.
 Long 84-52. at sunset hauled up to the N.E.

395. Saturday 29th Strong trades and cloudy at daylight kept
 off N.W. nothing in sight this day. noon Lat 12-08. S.
 Long 84-35. Sunset hauled up S.W. by the line.

396. Sunday 30th Moderate trades and pleasant at daylight kept
 off N.W. noon hauled by the line to the N.E. saw plenty
 black fish and one finback. Lat 11-34 S. Long 84-45. Chro
 84-48. Test.

397. Monday 31st Moderate and pleasant at 4 A.M. headed
 to the S.E. noon saw blackfish. Toward the Harbour
 and waist boats. took one to the Harbour boat. More
 seen in 2 places at 4 P.M. got him along side and fastened him
 in. noon Lat 11-11 S. Long 84-55. W.

398. Tuesday January 1st A.D. 1839. Light trades at daylight
 took in the Harbour boat to mend put out another
 one. saw black fish. at 1 P.M. finished the Star Boat put
 her up over head. noon Lat 11-17. Long 85-10. W.

399. Wednesday 2nd Moderate trades and Cloudy headed to the
 North and West. saw blackfish. Employed fitting the
 the Fore Stay. sunset hauled up N.E. noon Lat 9-42.
 Long 85-25. Chro 86-25. Test.

400. Thursday 3rd Moderate trades with passing rain squalls.
 at 6 A.M. headed N.W. saw blackfish at 8 P.M. hauled
 round to the N.E. by the line at 8 P.M. saw a ship ahead.
 noon Lat 8-55 S. Long 83-55. Chro 88-14. Test.

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401. Friday January 4th 1839. Moderate trades and Cloudy at 3 A.M.
 headed to the S.E. W. Employed boiling out the blackfish
 blubber. made 3 1/2 lbs. at noon headed to the S.E. noon Lat 9-15.
 Long 84-10. Chro 88-01. Test.

402. Saturday 5th Light trades and pleasant headed to the North and
 West. saw blackfish. noon Lat 8-33 S. Long by Lunar Obs.
 at 8 A.M. 87-46-45. Chro 87-57. 30.

403. Sunday 6th Moderate trades and pleasant headed to the North.
 at 1 P.M. saw 2 sperm whales. Toward the two Sea Boats and struck
 and killed both. at sunset got them along side noon Lat 7-06-
 Long Lunar Obs 87-18.



404. Monday 7th Fresh trades and pleasant at daylight commenced
 cutting at 8 P.M. got them all on board except one head. commenced
 boiling plenty of blackfish in fight. noon Lat 6-30 S. Long 87-00.

405. Tuesday 8th Light trades and pleasant at 10 A.M. commenced cutting
 the other head at 1 P.M. finished and traced traces forward
 to the N.E. by the line boiling. noon Lat 6-33 S. Long 86-58. Test.

406. Wednesday 9th Light trades and pleasant all hands employed
 boiling. the blubber running bad. headed to the North and
 East by the line. noon Lat 6-08 S. Long 85-14. Chro 86-14. Test.

407. Thursday 10th Light trades and pleasant employed boiling at
 noon finished saw breaches in the weather beam. made sail
 and tack to the S.E. W. at sunset finished washing of the decks.
 noon Lat 5-44 S. Long 86-18. Chro 86-18. Test.

408. Friday 11th Light and pleasant weather headed to the S.E. W.
 saw plenty of blackfish and two finbacks. noon Lat 6-09
 Long 86-14. Chro 86-45. 45. Chro 86-05. Test.
