

Ship Charles Coast of Peru. May 1839.

536 Sunday 19th Light airs and pleasant headed to the N.E. at 3 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales. lowered the boats succeeded in taking two, at sunset got them long side. wore ship headed to the S.W. with the head yards aback. Noon Lat^d 2-40 S. Long 84-33 West.

537 Monday 20th Light trades. at day light commenced tacking & 11 A.M. finished. made sail headed to the S.W. sunset began to boil. Noon Lat^d 2-12 S. Long 84-40 W.

538 Tuesday 21st Light airs and calm employed boiling the blubber and setting up Casks. headed to the N.E. Lat^d 2-12 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-11. Chs 85-11.

539 Wednesday 22^d Light airs and calm headed to the S.W. at daylight finished boiling and wore ship to the Eastward the two whales turned up 58 lbs. saw black fish. Noon Lat^d 2-06 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-15 W.

540 Thursday 23^d Light breezes and fine weather headed to the South. not employed breaking out between decks. at 4 P.M. wore ship to East. Noon Lat^d 2-06 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-39 West.

541 Friday 24th Light breezes and pleasant weather headed to the S.W. employed breaking out the fore hold saw finbacks. Noon Lat^d 2-32 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-57 West.

542 Saturday 25th Light airs and Calm. at day light commenced stowing down the oil at 5 P.M. finished the 3 Whales stowed down 82 lbs. headed to the N.E. noon Lat^d 3-03 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-48 West.

543 Sunday 26th Light airs from S.E. headed to the N.E. all hands at sea. noon headed to the S.W. Lat^d 2-30 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-50 West.

544 Monday 27th Light trades and pleasant headed to the N.E. saw twenty black fish. noon Lat^d 2-40 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-38 West.

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535 Tuesday May 28th Light trades and pleasant headed to the Eastward put out the Star Board and took in the Main Board to paint & 8 P.M. spoke the ship Augusta of New Bedford (Laurence) 11 months. 500 lbs. Noon. Lat^d 2-41 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-41 West.

536 Wednesday 29th Fresh trades and pleasant the Augusta in sight on the Weather Quater headed to the Eastward. Noon Lat^d 2-21 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-45 West.

537 Thursday 30th Light trades and pleasant weather. midnight headed to the S.W. by the Wind. painted the Main Board saw porpoises. Noon. Lat^d 2-30 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-13 West.

538 Friday 31st Light trades and fine weather saw finbacks and porpoises. noon headed to the Eastward. Lat^d 2-37 S. Long 84-40 W.

539 Saturday June 1st Light trades and cloudy weather daylight headed to the S.W. saw black fish. noon headed to the Eastward. Noon. Lat^d 2-16 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-55 West.

540 Sunday 2^d Light trades and cloudy. daylight headed to the S.W. saw black fish. noon headed to the Eastward. Lat^d 2-17 S. Long 84-40 W.

541 Monday 3^d Light trades and cloudy daylight headed to the S.W. saw black fish. Killers and porpoises. noon Lat^d 3-10 S. Long 84-40 W.

542 Tuesday 4th Fine trades and pleasant weather headed by the Wind to the S.W. saw black fish and finbacks. noon Lat^d 3-56 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-14-30. Chs 85-28-30 West.

543 Wednesday 5th Fresh trades and pleasant headed to the S.W. saw finbacks. noon headed to the East. employed tarring the rigging. Lat^d 5-7 S. Long 84-40 W. 85-56. Chs 85-45 West.
