794. Friday Jan 31st Hands employed loading and watering
at 2 P.M. got one raft along side & finished hoisting it in before
795. Saturday Feb'y 1st Employed painting, loading, got off
2 rafts of water. Sailed
796. Sunday 2nd All hands at Leaseway one watch on shore
on Liberty Island. Discharged Manual Pickers
797. Monday 3rd Employed loading and storing water also
taking potatoes on board & at sundown the watch returned
on board.
798. Tuesday 4th Daylight the Larboard watch went on
shore on Liberty. Employed storing potatoes. Pumpkins
cannons and water, soaked all night.
799. Wednesday 5th Employed storing wood and water.
Sundown the watch returned on board. Sailed.
800. Thursday 6th Employed on ship's duty. took in a raft
of Cask. got the boat stove and broke 2 bars on the bar discharge
Israel Elliot and Michael Holley. Sailed
801. Friday 7th Employed on ship's duty. got off boat load of wood
filled a barrel and brought them on board. Sailed
802. Saturday 8th Employed in ship's duty. got off 3 boats
load of wood and one raft of water got the Larboard boat to
land after wood.
803. Sunday 9th All hands at Leaseway

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804. ~~Tuesday~~ Monday 10th Employed getting ready for sea
got off 3 boat load of wood. Left Mr. Cleveland on shore sick
by his request. at 4 P.M. weighed anchor and stood to sea
Long at 4 P.M. Barometer 80-23-30. got the old boat badly stove.
805. Tuesday 11th Light Air and pleasant daylight saw
2 briggs steering to the South and East. Employed stowing the
anchors and getting the new boat ready noon Lat 24-48. Long 81-31-13. Bar 81-01-18.
806. Wednesday 12th Light Air with rain day light the sun
in sight. Heaved to the S. W. saw 1 black fish (Worm) Lat
2-45 S. Long 81-10-30. Fresh.
807. Thursday 13th Light Air and pleasant headed to the
Westward daylight saw a brig steering to the Eastward and
in ship's duty took in the old boat and put on the new
one. Noon Lat 3-09. Long 81-38. Bar 81-38.
808. Friday 14th Moderate and pleasant headed to the Westward
Employed in ship's duty. Mending the Larboard boat -
Noon Lat 3-52. S. Long 81-57-45. Fresh.
809. Saturday 15th Moderate and pleasant headed to the
S. W. Lat 4-40. saw sperm whales off the Weather beam &
covered the boats succeeded in taking one, noon got him along side
saw more at 2 P.M. covered again succeeded in taking another at 8 P.M.
got the whale along side. Lat by Dec 3-20. 
810. Sunday 16th Moderate and pleasant daylight commenced
cutting at 11 A.M. finished noon tackled ship to the S. W. by S
picked up the bar and a paddle that was lost yesterday
Noon Lat 2-56. Long 81-56. Bar 84-18. Fresh.
