 This day begins with strong gales from  
 ESE heddling S.W. by S. Close reef main top sail  
 fore sail stay sails middle part strong  
 gals at 4 o'clock. Ship to the light  
 set fore top sail spanker heddling do land  
 Lat by Obs 23° 25' N Long by Ch 28° 54' W

Saturday November <sup>1856</sup> 22  
 This day begins with brisk breezes from  
 the S.W. heddling by the winds by S. more  
 moderate middle part lat ten part  
 fine weather heddling by the winds  
 by S. saw noth thing so land this day  
 Lat by Obs 24° 00' N Long by Ch 29° 58' W

Sunday November <sup>1856</sup> 23
