Monday December ^{Ch¹} 1856
These 24 hours begins with fine weather the ding in shore to the st. at sunset took to the st. boat washes at 10 AM took to the st. fine weather but ten part the same the is salt and boneverte in site so ends this day Lat 13° 45' N Long 16° 29' W

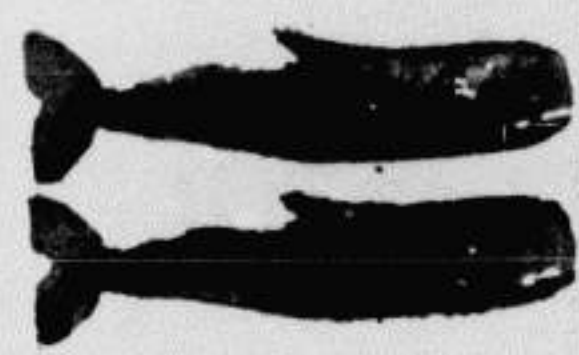
Tuesday December ^{Ch²} 1856
This day begins with fine weather the ding by the wind to the st. bottom the to is salt and boneverte mid dept strong breeze is the ding st. light saw a sail the ding by the wind to the st. Lat 13° 45' N Long 15° 14' W

Wednesday December ^{Ch³} 1856
This day begins with strong trade the ding st. light at 5 AM saw black fish at sunset reefed the top sails the st. mid dept the same but ten part strong trade the ding to the st. at 10 AM Cap of to the south made sail so ends Lat 13° 45' N Long 14° 09' W

Remarks on Thursday December ^{Ch⁴} 1856

These 24 hours begins with strong trade smoky weather steering S by E mid dept fine weather but ten part the same saw noth thing so ends this day

Friday December ^{Ch⁵} 1856

These 24 hours begins with fine weather wind from the st. steering S saw porpses mid dept fine weather but ten part the same saw noth thing so ends this day

Saturday December ^{Ch⁶} 1856

These 24 hours begins with fine lite wind from the st. steering S all sail mid dept fine weather but ten part the same at 10 AM saw black fish lower for them got noth thing so ends

Sunday December ^{Ch⁷} 1856

These 24 hours begins with fine weather lite wind from the st. steering S by E at 5 PM saw black fish lower for them got a porpses mid dept fine weather wind from the st. at day light the wind from the st. at 10 AM had a squall reef the top sails so ends one sail in site

Monday December ^{Ch⁸} 1856

These 24 hours begins with calms with a sea on mid dept lite wind from the st. steering S by E later part fine weather at 9 AM saw black fish lower got to so ends this day

Tuesday December ^{Ch⁹} 1856

This day begins with fine weather lite wind from the st. steering S by E mid dept the same but ten part lite was in play in sailing the blackfish saw one fin back so ends this day
