This day begins with light airs calms at 4 PM. Light
airs from S. strong by the wind to SE & mid the part
light airs calms lat ten part much the same saw
nothing but black fish so ended this day

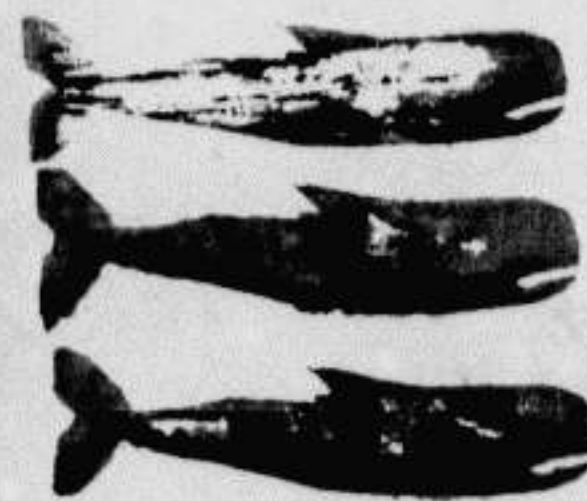
Friday December 12 1856
This day begins with light winds from SE & strong SE by E
at 5 PM. Had a squall from E took in top gal. Landed
them mid the part light airs calms lat ten
part the same so ended this day saw nothing

Saturday December 13 1856
This day begins with squall by weather
winds. Light from all quarters at 5 PM. Had
a strong squall from N & E. Top sail
top of sail saw black fish mid the part fine
weather lat ten part the same light winds from E
had day SSE saw nothing so ended

Sunday December 14 1856
These 24 hours begins with fine weather light
winds from E by SE had day SSE & SE sail
mid the part light airs lat ten part
calms so ended this day calms



Monday December 15 1856
This day begins with calms at 2 PM. Saw
black fish heard got three mid the
part light airs calms lat ten part the same
saw nothing so ended this day
Set in 5.19 at Long 158° 34' W

Tuesday December 16 1856
This day begins with light airs calms from
South the day to middle part calms lat ten part
the same saw nothing so ended this day

Lat 5° 14' N

Wednesday December 17 1856
This day begins with calms finished sailing
the black fish mid the part light squalls
of rain lat ten part calms so ended this day

Lat 5° 05' N
Long 144° 46' W

Thursday December 18 1856
This day begins with calms at 5 PM. Light
winds from S had day to E. S. mid the part
light airs calms lat ten part the same so ended

Lat 5° 19' N
Long 141° 16' W

Friday December 19 1856
This day begins with calms mid the part much
the same at 6 PM. Saw a brig heading to the west
light airs calms saw nothing set up the mizen
riggin and other jobs a boat ship so ended

Lat 5° 21' N
Long 134° 47' W

Saturday December 20 1856
This day begins with light airs calms from all
quarters at 1 PM. Light airs from SSE had day to E
mid the part light airs from SSE lat ten part
calms begin in site so ended this day

Lat 5° 40' N
Long 124° 56' W

Sunday December 21 1856
This day begins with light airs from South
strong to SE the long fore masts of the SE
strong the same mid the part light winds lat ten
part the same saw a humpback so ended

Lat 6° 26' N
Long 120° 15' W

Monday December 22 1856
This day begins with light winds from SSE had day
to and to SE mid the part the same lat ten
part light winds saw nothing so ended
