This day began with fine weather winds
from SW steering SE middle part fine
weather lat ten part the same wind from South

point calms lat ten part lite winds from the heading to the
South saw porpoises so ended this day

This day began with fine weather lite winds from
SW by W steering SW to SSW middle part the
same at 9 AM took to the SE saw noth thing
but porpoises so ended this day

This day began with fine weather lite winds
from the SSW steering SE by E middle part the
same lat ten part fine weather heading SE

took him in canoe with a squall lat
ten point winds from SE to WSW so ended

lite winds from WSW to SSW middle part the
same lat ten part squally with rains winds from
SW steering SE so ended this day rain no

Friday January ^{the} 2 1857
These 24 hours began with cloudy weather
lite rain at 1 PM cleared up saw a brig to the
SE heading to the South middle part calms
lat ten part lite winds from W steering SE
imply ed in hailing the black fish at 11 came
a squall from SE with heavy rains so ended

Saturday January ^{the} 3 1857
This day began with calms cleared of middle
part lite winds lat ten part moon the same at 9 AM
saw black fish banded got one took him
in cap of SE wind at 4 PM so ended this day
