Tuesday January 12th 1854
These 24 hours began with brisk breezes from
W 3/4 S steering 3 & at 6 PM squall lay mid dept
fine weather lat ten part the same so ended this day

Wednesday January 13th 1854
This day began with late wind from South
steering 3 & at 1 PM the wind shifted in a squall
to the NE & mid dept fine weather lat ten part
the same late wind from the South so ended this day

Thursday January 14th 1854
These 24 hours began with late wind from South
steering 3 & 3/4 all sail set mid dept squall
lat ten part the same with heavy rain wind
late from SE to SW so ended this day

Friday January 15th 1854
These 24 hours began with late wind from the
W 3/4 S steering 3 & 3/4 mid dept the same lat ten
part squall lay weather late wind from W 3/4 S
steering 3 & saw nothing so ended this day

day light saw prince's island bearing SE dist 25 miles
late wind calms so ended this day. The day 3 & 3/4

Monday January 12th 1854
This day began with late wind from the W 3/4 steering
to the South to the SE of the island at 4 PM saw
black fish loosed for thin got nothing at sun
set shortened sail steering to the South at
day light made sail prince's island in site
at 10 AM had a squall from SE with rain
saw nothing so ended late rain

Tuesday January 13th 1854
These 24 hours began with late wind from
the W 3/4 steering to the South west mid dept
steering west wind from SE at daylight
made sail to the SE at 7 PM saw black fish
loosed got four of them so ended calms

Wednesday January 14th 1854
This day began with fine weather at 3
PM loosed for black fish got nothing
at 7 PM had a squall from the SE with
thunder and heavy rain steering SW
mid dept fine weather wind from SE
steering SW lat ten part fine weather in played
in boiling the black fish prince's island
in site so ended this day
