These 24 hours begins with fine weather heading by the wind to the N of us the land in site to the N of us at sun set took ship to the S shorted sail mid dle part fine weather lat ten point the same at day light made sail heading SSW so land this day

Saturday January ^{the} 17 1857
These 24 hours begins with fine weather heading by the wind to the SSW mid dle part the same at 5 o'clock took to the W at 9 took to the south came up a squall with heavy rain thunder lighting so land this day heavy rains calms

Sunday January ^{the} 18 1857
This day begins with rain ney at 3 pm clouded up heading N at 6 pm took to the south mid dle part fine weather lat ten point came on with a heavy squall from SSW with thunder lighting took in sail to reef top sails at 10 o'clock clouded up calms made sail so land this day

Monday January ^{the} 19 1857
This day begins with fine weather heading by the wind WSW at sun set took to the SSW mid dle part fine weather at day light took to the WSW at 7 o'clock came on with a squall from SSW with heavy rains at 8 o'clock wind from N to WSW at 10 cleared of wind from the SSW to SSW made sail heading WSW

Tuesday January ^{the} 20 1857
This day begins with fine weather heading WSW at midnight took to the SSW lat ten point late and calms saw noth thing so land this day

Wednesday January ^{the} 21 1857
This day begins with lite wind heading to the W at 4 pm saw a sail to the N of us at 6 the wind shifted took to the SSW at 9 took to the W which breezes the lat ten point the same St Thomas in sight to the WSW saw noth thing more so land this day

Thursday January ^{the} 22 1857
These 24 hours begins with fine weather fine breeze from south heading WSW for the N point of St Thomas at sun set shortened sail land 20 miles of mid dle part late and calms at day light late and from the SSW heading to the W the 20 miles dist ore sail to the S of us at 9 o'clock saw black fish leaved for them at noon got three to the ship so land this day

Friday January ^{the} 23 1857
This day begins with lite and calms the boats of at 9 pm got a long side with to men took them in lite squalls of rain took in sail heading of shore mid dle part the same at day light took in shore commenced hauling a brig in site merchant man the 25 miles of so land this day
