Sunday January ^{Ch^y 25} 1854
this day begins with fine weather at 1 pm
took in shoer at 6 pm lite ars from S to
the ding to the west ward the land 4 miles of
at 9 the ding the same at mid night the ding in shoer
at 4 the ding in shoer the land 5 miles of
hood or squall from W to the ding W to the ding
at noon cleared up sun the land 8 miles of to the
S to of us so land this day steering W lite wind

Monday January ^{Ch^y 26} 1854
this day begins with squall weather at 2 pm
cleared up wind led to steering W at 6 pm the land
bearing S to S to 15 miles mid dle part mid night
at 9 the ding now ship to the south at 4 came on squall
the ding south to S to the ding rains at 11 the ding
up sun saw the south point of St Thomas
bearing S to S to 20 miles so land rainey

Tuesday January ^{Ch^y 27}
then 24 hours begins with squall weather
weather at 4 pm cleared up sun saw black
fish lower ed got one took him in reef the top
still squall weather the ding S to S to mid
point heavy rains at 8 the ding cleared up sun
at day light made sail too ship to the W
at 7 the land in saw black fish came
up a heavy squall with heavy thunder
heavy rains lasted from the day since
from S to steering S to so land this day

Wednesday January ^{Ch^y 28} 1854
this day begins with lite wind from S to the ding
steering S to at 4 pm the south point of St Thomas
bearing S to S to 20 miles dirt came on with the
rains mid dle part fine weather too ship to the
W at day light made sail at 6 the ding saw black fish
lower ed got one took him in reef at 10 saw him again
lower ed got in played in boiling so land

Thursday January ^{Ch^y 29} 1854
this day begins with fine weather the ding
by the wind to the W saw number of fin back
at sun set took in main top gal lard mid dle part
fine weather the ding S to at ten point the ding W to
saw noth thing but one fin back so land this day

Friday January ^{Ch^y 30} 1854
this day begins with fine weather the ding
by the wind to the W at sun set took to the S to
at ten point the ding the same so land this day

Saturday January ^{Ch^y 31} 1854
then 24 hours begins with fine weather
the ding by the wind to the S to at 9 took
to the W at 3 the ding took to the S to strong breeze
at 11 the ding mad noth saw noth thing so land

Sunday February ^{Ch^y 1} 1854
this day begins with fine weather the ding
by the wind S to S to at sun set short time sail
the ding the same at mid night took to
W at 1 took to S to S to at day light
saw the island on shore the ding south
at 2 1/2 miles lite wind the ding for the
land so land this day
