This day began with fine weather late wind  
from South steering at 6 pm. shortened  
sail heading to the W mid the part the  
same at day light made sail heading W  
saw noth thing so ended this day

Long 111° 39' E

Wednesday February <sup>Ch. 25</sup>  
This day began with fine weather  
saw a fin back leave at 10 am then got lost  
on to one at sunset shortened sail head  
ing at W lay a back for the night at day  
light made sail steering at W saw noth thing

Lat 7° 12' S

Thursday February <sup>Ch. 26</sup>  
This day began with fine weather steering  
at W saw a fin back leave at 10 am shot a  
burn in to him did not get him mid depart  
fine weather but ten part calm so ended

Lat 6° 38' S  
Long 111° 06' E

Friday February <sup>Ch. 27</sup>  
This day began with calm at 10 pm late wind  
from SW steering at sunset shortened sail  
steering the same at mid night came to head  
ing to the W a back at day light made sail  
steering at W at 9 AM left by the wind to W  
saw noth thing so ended this day

Lat 6° 13' S

Saturday February <sup>Ch. 28</sup>  
This day began with fine weather heading  
by the wind to the W at sunset shortened  
sail heading the same at day light  
made sail steering by the wind W at 8  
saw noth thing so ended this day

Lat 6° 18' S  
Long 91° 17' E

Sunday March <sup>Ch. 1</sup> 1857  
This day began with fine weather  
heading by the wind to W at 4 pm saw  
a merchant brig heading by the wind  
to the E mid the part but ten part fine weather

Lat 6° 34' S  
Long 91° 17' E

Monday March <sup>Ch. 2</sup> 1857  
This day began with fine weather heading  
to the SW by W saw a fin back at sunset short  
ened sail at mid night took to the E at day  
light saw a sail to the E of us at 10 AM  
took ship to the W saw noth thing so ended

Lat 6° 46' S  
Long 81° 48' E

Tuesday March <sup>Ch. 3</sup>  
This day began with fine weather at 4 pm  
spoke the brig. church of mottaport clear  
mid the part late wind at ten part strong  
breeze heading SE at noon took to the W  
saw a fin back so ended this day

Lat 6° 44' S  
Long 91° 00' E

Wednesday March <sup>Ch. 4</sup>  
This day began with fine weather saw  
one fin back at sunset shortened sail mid  
the part fine weather at day light made  
sail heading SE by E saw the brig. branch  
heading to the W saw grampires so ended

Lat 6° 50' S  
Long 91° 10' E

Thursday March <sup>Ch. 5</sup> 1857  
This day began with fine weather at 4 pm  
took to the W at sunset shortened sail  
mid the part fine weather at day light  
made sail heading to the E by E at 9 took  
to the WNW saw noth thing at noon  
took to the SE by E so ended this day
