This day began with fine weather heading S.E.
at sun set short end sail middle part fine
weather lat ten part the same so kind

Sunday March Feb 8 1854
This day began with fine weather heading
by the winds S.E. at sun set short end sail
at day light took to the W saw to sails to the
South of us at noon saw that they had
their boats down chasing a school
took to the S.E. heading for the boats

Monday March 9th 1854
This day began with fine weather
heading for the boats at 2 pm saw
a large whale the other ships boats
clart on welcomed to boats got clart
on still in ear of the whale at 4 pm
the boat got lost the whale took
the line the whale came up the stern
board boat got a long side of the whale
did not get lost saw the whale
number of times could not engrave
at dark came on board the brig
Ksallent of Mat tapouette and the brig
pavilion Helones toll middle part
calms lat ten part the same both
sails in site so kind calms

Tuesday March Feb 10 1854
This day began with calms at 5 pm
had a breeze from W.S.W. to sails in
site saw noth thing of the fish line
middle part fine weather at day light made
sail back to the W the two brigs in site to the E
saw one fin back so kind took to the S.E.

Wednesday March Feb 11 1854
This day began with fine weather to brig
in site to the S.E. of us middle part fine
weather lat ten part the same saw two
sails saw fin backs so kind this day

Thursday March Feb 12
This day began with light calms heading
to the W.S.W. at 5 pm light squall of rain
from S.E. at sun set short end sail middle
part fine weather at day light made sail brisk
brigs steering N.W. at 10 came by the winds to the
W saw fin back so kind this day

Friday March Feb 13 1854
This day began with strong breezes heading
W by N middle part the same at day light made
sail heading N by E saw noth thing so kind

Saturday March Feb 14 1854
This day began with fine weather heading
by the winds to the W at 3 1/2 pm saw black
tack ship for them loosed got noth thing
at sun set short end sail heading S.E. middle
part the same at day light took ship to the
W saw the brig march to the N and
of us saw grampse so kind this day
