part the same but ten part fine weather
fine breeze heading W by S so ended this day

Monday March ²³ 1854
This day began with fine weather heading
W by the wind midle part strong wind
but ten part the same saw no other thing so ended

Tuesday March ²⁴ 1854
This day began with brisk breezes stinging
S & saw number of shoals of porpoises at sun set
up by the wind to the S & shortened sail lite wind
midle part fine weather midle part the same
at day light saw a schooner at 10 & at 11 spoke the
the Kate Cory of Westport pt 10 month
out 130 char-vels so ended this day

Wednesday March ²⁵ 1854
This day began with fine weather heading
to the S & to sails in site at sun set shortened
sail midle part fine weather at day
light made sail heading to the S & S &
at 10 at 11 tack ship to the W three sails
in site saw fire back so ended
