This day begins with fine weather heading by the wind to the S.E. saw a grampus shot him with a cum lance leaned for him did not get him he sunk mid part fine weather lat ten part the same saw fin backs

Tuesday April ^{Ch. 7}

This day begins with fine weather heading W by the wind saw number species of squid at sunset shortened sail heading to the S.E. mid part strong breezes at day light took ship to the W by strong winds so ended

Wednesday April ^{Ch. 8}

This day begins with strong breezes heading W by the wind at 3 pm moderated cleared of mid part strong winds lat ten part the same at 10 AM took to the S.E. & saw nothing

Thursday April ^{Ch. 9}

This day begins with strong breezes heading to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail at day light made sail saw porpoises so ended this day

Friday April ^{Ch. 10} 1854

This day begins with fine weather steering to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail heading to the S.E. at day light made sail heading to the W saw nothing so ended

Saturday April ^{Ch. 11}

This day begins with light winds heading N.W. mid part heading W at day light made sail heading the same so ended

Sunday April ^{Ch. 12} 1854

This day begins with light winds heading to the W at sunset shortened sail mid part fine weather at day light made sail heading the same saw porpoises jumpers so ended this day

Monday April ^{Ch. 13}

This day begins with fine weather at sunset took ship to the S.E. shortened sail mid part fine weather at day light made sail at 4 pm of N saw fin backs at 10 AM steering S.E. so ended

Tuesday April ^{Ch. 14}

This day begins with fine weather steering to the S.W. at 1 PM saw whales leaned for them the whales going quick to the S.E. at 3 got up with them got fast to one small one the other whales did not stop shot in to one long whale with a cum lance did not get on to him the whales went out of site took the whale a long side cut him in made sail heading to the S.E. mid part fine weather lat ten part foggy with late squalls of rain so ended this day

This day begins with more cleared weather at 2 pm took to the S.E. mid part fine weather at day light took ship to the W by W commenced boiling saw nothing so ended this day

This day begins with fine weather at 6 pm finished boiling shortened sail to S.E. mid part fine weather lat ten part the same saw nothing so ended
