This day begins with fine weather bound for the port at 4 pm came to anchor at Kabenda the W. Henry the dye and the port lat ten part fine weather so birds

This day fine but a heavy well heaving we mid the port fine lat ten part employed in getting of wood and wash on shore

Friday May 15th

This day begins with fine weather employed in getting of wood lat ten part mainly and wash on shore so birds this day

Saturday May 16th 1857

This day begins with fine weather employed in getting wood water taking out sum of the ground then cast stowing them back a gain

Sunday May 17th

This day begins with fine weather one wash on shore employed in painting middle part lat ten part fine weather so birds

Monday May 18th

This day begins with fine weather middle part fine weather lat ten part employed in painting stowing wood water the William Henry went to see so birds

Tuesday May 19th 1857

This day begins with fine weather Mr. Flourton the third mate had his dis charge being his request all hands employed in getting water stowing down finished painting the dye went out middle part fine lat ten part the same employed in stow away wood water

Wednesday May 20th

This day begins with fine weather employed in stowing away wood getting of wood at daylight sent in a raft for water at 10 got it in got clamped up. And the boat steved went on shore to get sum close observed
