Wednesday May 27

This day begins with fine weather at 4 pm tack ship to the S & at 6 pm spoke the Soul Thomas of Mattapoiset middle part fine weather at 6 o'clock tack ship to the W saw fin backs prop etc so tried this day

Friday May 29 1857

This day begins with fine weather heading by the wind to the W at sunset shortened sail tack to the S & middle part fine weather at day light went ship to the W of us saw to sails in site saw fin backs so tried this day lite wind heading W

Saturday May 30 1857

This day begins with fine weather heading to the W at 4 o'clock spoke the Congue Pearl of New London middle part strong wind lat ten part much the same saw fin backs hump backs at 10 o'clock tack to the W so tried

Sunday May 31 1857

This day begins with strong breezes at 4 pm tack to the S & middle part strong wind lat ten part the same very good saw number of fin backs so tried
