This day begins with fine weather steering N.E. saw fine back porpoises mid part fine weather lat ten part fine weather steering N.W. saw noth thing so ended

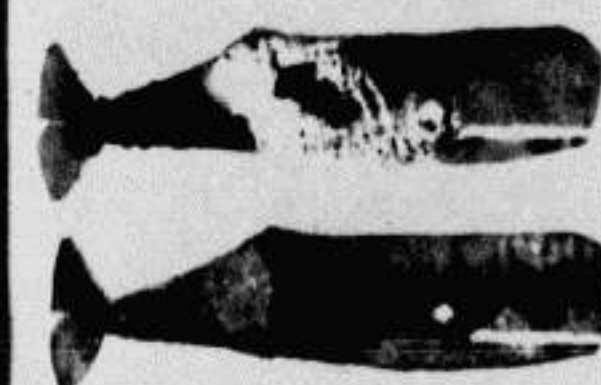

Saturday June 20

This day begins with fine weather at 7 pm finished the boiler at 3 o'clock finished boiling lat ten part fine weather so ended

Sunday June 21

This day begins with fine weather holding to the N. at sunset shortened sail mid part fine weather lat ten part the same so ended this day

Monday June 22 1857

This day begins with fine weather holding to the N. by the winds to the S.E. mid part fine lat ten part the same employed in stowing down the oil saw noth thing so ended

Tuesday June 23

This day begins with fine weather holding to the N. by the winds finished stowing of weather mid part lite wind lat ten part the same saw noth thing so ended this day
