This day begins with lite wind smoky weather  
mid all part the same at day light made sail to the  
ESE thick smoky weather saw noth thing  
so ended this day

Wednesday July 1 1854  
This day begins with thick weather with  
lite squalls of miss saw porpoises at sun  
set shortened sail to the WSE mid all  
part lite winds at day light made sail cap  
of NW by W saw noth thing but fir backer so ended

Thursday July 2  
This day begins with fine weather steering NW  
at 4 pm came up thick smoky weather  
mid all part lite wind at day light made sail  
cap of NW saw black fish larvae got one  
saw number of fir backer so ended this day

Friday July 3  
This day begins with brisk breezes steering  
NW at sun set shortened sail by the winds  
mid all part fine weather at day light  
cap of W in played in repairing the jib so ended

Saturday July 4  
This day begins with fine weather steering  
NW at sun set shortened sail heading  
to the W mid all part fine weather lat ten  
part the same at 10 o'clock cap of NW saw noth  
thing so ended this day boiled out the black fish

Sunday July 5  
This day begins with fine weather  
steering NW at 2 pm saw the island  
of Anacchone bearing N 81st 45 miles  
at sun set shortened sail to the W mid all  
part fine weather lat ten part the same  
heading by the winds to the WSW at noon  
took to the ESE saw noth thing so ended
