This day begins with fine weather heading  
by the wind to the S & saw hump backs the  
land 14 miles off mid dle part moderate weather  
at day light cap of for the island at noon got to  
anchor so ended this day fine weather

Thursday July 9<sup>th</sup> 1857  
This day begins with fine weather mid dle  
part the same lat ten part fine weather got  
a few potatoes a few yams so ended this day

This day begins with fine weather at 2 pm  
the boat came off with all that they could get  
at 3 took anchor came to see heading to the  
S & mid dle part lite wind at day light made  
sail saw fin backs at 10 m saw a sail so ended

to the S & mid dle part heading S & at day light  
cap of S & S & S make weather saw fin backs

Sunday July 12<sup>th</sup> 1857  
This day begins with lite wind steering  
at sunset short time sail at 10 tack of shore at 2 m  
tack to the S & at day light made sail heading to  
at 10 m saw the land at 11 saw a sail so ended

Monday July 13<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with strong breezes steering in &  
at sunset short time sail at 10 pm tack to the W  
at 2 m tack to the S & at day light made sail  
steering to at 10 m saw the land at 11 saw a sail  
saw hump backs so ended this day land 10 miles  
off to the south of cape Lopez so ended this day

Tuesday July 14<sup>th</sup> 1857  
This day begins with fine weather at 1 pm loaded  
for a hump back did not get on at 3 loaded again  
did not get on to them at 8 pm came to anchor  
at cape Lopez the brig Anne spent in company  
at 8 m took an anchor came out saw no hump  
backs in the bay in ployed in boiling the  
blackfish so ended this day steering to the E

Wednesday July 15<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with strong wind saw hump  
backs at 14 pm loaded for them did not  
get on saw killers got fast to tails of their  
got one took him in at night short time  
sail heading of to the W mid dle part later  
part strong wind may get in ployed in killing  
saw noth thing so ended this day

Thursday July 16<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with strong breezes rugged  
heading by the wind to the W & W saw to hump backs  
mid dle part strong breezes lat ten part the  
same steering at W saw noth thing but saw  
fin back so ended heading by the wind at 10 m
