This day begins with brisk breezes heading by the wind W by W at 3 pm saw 50 tomes bearing W by W dist 28 miles at sun set shore land sail took to the S by S at mid night took in shore at day light made sail heading in shore saw noth thing but one hump back so ended

Saturday July The 15

This day begins with light winds heading in for the island at 4 pm the land 8 miles of mid all part like a calm at 8 o'clock there a breeze from S W heading of shore at 11 took in shore at noon the land 8 miles of S by S

Sunday July The 16

This day begins with strong winds cap of run down a long shore at 4 pm heading of shore to the W by W at sun set shore land sail heading of at mid night took in at daylight strong winds rugged cap of run down the island at 11 o'clock saw a hump back leaved for him did not get on so ended this day the land 6 miles of

Monday July The 17

This day begins with light winds clst in shore saw to hump backs leaved for them got noth thing cap of steering by S mid all part like winds at daylight made all sail like wind heading to the at 10 o'clock strong winds took in the like sails so ended this day heading S by S the land in sight

Tuesday July The 18 1854

This day begins with strong winds heading S by S mid all part the same at day light made sail heading S by S saw noth thing so ended

Wednesday July The 19 1854

This day begins with moderate winds steering S by S the wind saw noth thing but porpoises at sun set took in main sail mid all part like wind at day light made sail at 4 o'clock Cape Lopez in sight saw number of hump backs so ended

Thursday July The 20 1854

This day begins with fine weather heading in S by S at 8 pm took to the S W saw at 4 took to the S by S at 6 came to anchor in 4 fathoms mid all part fine weather at day light started with the boats down the bay at 9 o'clock saw one hump back in the bay did not get on

Friday July The 21

This day begins with fine weather saw noth thing in the bay mid all part fine weather at ten past the same saw noth thing so ended

Saturday July The 22

This day begins with fine weather all the boats of crasing up and down the bay saw noth thing at daylight started with the boats crasing the bay saw noth thing so ended

Sunday July The 23

This day begins with fine weather at 3 pm saw a hump back in the bay did not get on to him mid all part fine weather at daylight leaved the boats saw a hump back could not get on to him chost him out of the bay so ended

Monday July The 24

This day begins with strong winds saw noth thing mid all part fine weather at day light started with the boats at 11 o'clock came on shore saw noth thing in the bay so ended this day
