at day light took ship to the S.W. made sail
strong breezes saw nothing so knes

Wednesday November ^{Chⁿ 4}

Long 35° 44' W

This day begins with strong breezes at 1 pm
saw keeches cepson them saw no more
of them one sail in site at sunset shortened
sail middle part latter part strong breezes head
ing to the S.W. one sail in site so knes this day

Lat 19° 09' S

This day begins with strong winds rugged
heading to the S.W. middle part latter part
the same one sail in site saw jimson
so knes this day cloud day weather

Friday November ^{Chⁿ 6}

Lat 20° 14' S

This day begins with cloudy weather
late arrives to sails in site at sunset
shortened sail middle part strong
breezes at day light moderate made
sail at 11 AM saw a ship heading to
the S.W. so knes this day

Saturday November ^{Chⁿ 7}

Lat 20° 31' S
Long 33° 29' W

This day begins with brisk breezes.
squally weather one sail in site
at sunset shortened sail middle
part strong breezes at day light made
sail saw to sails so knes this day

Sunday November ^{Chⁿ 8}

Lat 20° 12' S
Long 32° 10' W

This day begins with rainy weather
ruins from the S.W. heading to the S.W.
middle part rainy latter part much the
same saw a large steamer so knes this day

Monday November ^{Chⁿ 9}

Lat 20° 11' S
Long 30° 25' W

This day begins with squally weather heading
by the winds to the S.W. middle part rainy
at sunset cleared at day light made sail head
ing S.W. so knes this day one sail in site

Tuesday November ^{Chⁿ 10}

Lat 20° 18' S
Long 31° 19' W

This day begins with strong breezes heading to the
S.W. at 1 pm spoke the Clarke Montezuma of New
Bedford 14 months out with 700 barrels of rice
south at 4 pm tack to the S.W. at sunset short
ened sail at day light made sail strong breezes head

Wednesday November ^{Chⁿ 11}

Lat 19° 17' S
Long 31° 20' W

This day begins with strong winds rugged weather heading
to the S.W. saw one sail middle part strong
breezes latter part the same rugged so knes

Thursday November ^{Chⁿ 12}

Lat 19° 26' S

This day begins with strong winds rugged
heading to the S.W. middle part heading to the
S.W. latter part the same strong winds
rugged saw one sail so knes this day
