brecken a man charst ship came along  
Koolies she saw to whals the day to the  
leard of us saw noth thing of them  
at 10 o'clock finished cutting so land this day

Wednesday December <sup>The</sup> 2  
This day begins with strong breezes saw  
small brecken to the South of us did not  
give up with them mid de point fine weather  
at day light commenced hauling war ship  
to the N E to sails in leard South so land

Thursday December <sup>The</sup> 3  
This day begins with lite wind saw  
swell on saw three sails leard S  
mid de point fine weather at 4 o'clock strong  
wind equalley saw one sail at 9 o'clock finished  
hauling saw brecken strong wind rugged so land

Friday December <sup>The</sup> 4  
This day begins with strong wind rugged hel ding  
to the N E mid de point strong wind  
at day light war ship to the South so land

Saturday December <sup>The</sup> 5  
This day begins with strong breezes hel ding  
S E one sail in site mid de point strong  
wind at day light commenced stowing  
down the oil at noon fire is hel wash  
ed of so land this day
