this day began with strong breezes and good weather at 3 p.m. came up squally near the top sail at 5 p.m. saw two sails to the S. of us middle point strong winds at 5 o'clock came on with heavy rain strong winds nigger so kind they name

this day began with heavy rain with strong gales from E. to S. W. or had seen an middle point strong gales with rain at 4 saw a ship steering N. E. at 8 o'clock near ship to the S. E. & W. from south long ing to with close reef top sails

this day began with heavy gals nigger heavy rain middle point more moderate heavy rain at ten point closed up sail with lite winds heavy swell on made sun sail so kind this day

this day began with lite winds closed day weather at 2 p.m. came on with rain near the top sails at 5 p.m. closed up sail with lite and from S. E. three sails in site middle point lite wind squally at ten point much the same to sails in site ahead south so kind

Friday December 11 1857
this day began with lite wind from all quarters with lite squalls from one sail in site ahead south middle point lite wind at ten point squally weather holding to the south so kind saw noth thing

Saturday December 12
this day began with squally weather at 11 p.m. closed of saw to large sail bound south middle point fine weather at day light made all sail fine weather one sail in site at 10 o'clock saw killers bound for them stuck got one so kind lite squall

Sunday December 13
this day began with moderate weather holding by the wind to the S. E. & W. middle point the same at day light made sail steering S. at 10 o'clock at W. saw a ship bound south saw noth thing so kind this day steering S. E.

Monday December 14
this day began with fine weather steering W. S. W. to south middle point fine weather at ten point the same at 10 o'clock up of W. saw noth thing so kind this day

Tuesday December 15
this day began with fine weather steering S. W. at 10 o'clock set short ten sail by the wind at 16 o'clock at day light made all sail fine weather saw noth thing so kind
