by the wind N.W. saw fine back jumpers
at sunset shortened sail middle point strong
breezes at day light made sail at 9 saw breakers
to the N.E. made all sail at 11 tack to the S.E.
saw noth thing more of them so tender

Wednesday December ^{The} 23
This day begins with brisk breezes heeling
to the N.E. by N. middle point fine weather
at day light made sail heeling to the N.W.
saw noth thing but to sails so tender this day

Thursday December ^{The} 24
This day begins with fine weather saw
to sails bound south at 3 pm tack to the S.E.
at day light made all sail to the N.W. fine
weather saw noth thing so tender this day

Friday December ^{The} 25
This day begins with fine weather heeling
by the wind to the S.E. middle point late
point the same saw noth thing so tender

Saturday December ^{The} 26
This day begins with fine weather saw
all sail at 6 pm saw ship to the N. middle
point squally lat ten point the same
saw five sails bound to the S.W. saw noth
thing of the fish kind so tender this day
