to rising did not get up with him being
dark came on board and dined to the 188

at noon went ship to 188° later winds

Tuesday December 29
This day began with fine weather heading
188° at 5 pm saw a sail to the 188
midle part strong winds at day light made
sail to the 188 saw nothing so ended

This day began with brisk breezes from the
188 heading to the 188 midle part the same at 5
188 took to the 188 W strong winds squally
saw nothing so ended this day heading 188°

This day began with strong breezes squally
saw a sail bound to the 188 at sunset near the
top sails then dined 188 W midle part
strong breezes later point the same
saw one sail bound to the 188
so ended this day more moderate

Friday January ^{The} 1 1855
This day began with more moderate
at sunset shortened sail then dined
midle part fine weather later point the
same at day light up of 188 saw nothing so ended

Saturday January ^{The} 2
This day began with fine weather steering
188 W at 4 pm saw a sail bound to the south
at sunset shortened sail by the winds 188°
midle part later point fine weather
saw one fin back so ended steering 188°

Sunday January ^{The} 3
This day began with fine weather steering
188 W winds 188° at sunset shortened
sail by the winds 188° midle part fine
later point the same steering 188° saw
a large whale bound to the 188° so ended this day

Monday January ^{The} 4
This day began with fine weather steering
188 W at sunset shortened sail by the winds 188°
at day light made sail steering 188° on board
the main sail to repair saw porpoises so ended

Tuesday January ^{The} 5
This day began with fine weather steering
188 W finished the main sail bent it at sunset
shortened sail by the winds to the 188°
midle part later dined with some rain
thunder lightning later point later dined
steering 188° bent fore top sail repaired
it one sail in site so ended later dined
