This day began with fine weather the ding
by the wind to the S.S. the number of sails in site
middle part late wind lat ten part the same
saw three sails bound at 10 ends this day

Wednesday January 13
This day began with squally weather
the ding by the wind to the S.S. at sunset
shortened sail middle part very rain
lat ten part squally with rain so ends

Thursday January 14
This day began with squally weather
the ding by the wind to the S.S. at sunset
shortened sail middle part fine weather
lat ten part the same saw north thing

Friday January 15
This day began with fine weather the ding
by the wind to the S.S. at sunset shortened
sail middle part fine weather
at day light on ship to the west
made sail saw a ship bound south
saw north thing of the fish kind so ends
