this day began with brisk breezes heading
to the NW at sun set shortened sail mid
point fine weather but ten part much the
same saw to sails bound & so ended

Sunday January 17th
this day began with fine weather heading
by the wind to the NW at sun set short-
ened sail heading to the SE mid afternoon
fine weather but ten part the same heading
by SE saw one sail so ended this day

Monday January 18th
this day began with fine weather heading
by the wind to the SE mid afternoon the same
at day light made sail tack to the NW fine
weather saw nothing so ended this day

Long 36° 58' 41"

Tuesday January 19th
this day began with light wind squalls
of rain at 2 pm cleared of rain heading to
the SE by 6 at sun set shortened sail heading
to the NW mid afternoon the same but ten
part fine weather saw one sail so ended

Wednesday January 20th
this day began with fine weather
at 4 pm took to the SE mid afternoon
the same at day light made sail steering South
at 9 o'clock the wind employed in taking up one
ground ten cash liking so ended this day

Thursday January 21st
this day began with fine weather heading
by the wind to the SE at day light made sail
to the NW fine weather saw nothing
but one sail found SW so ended

Friday January 22nd
this day began with fine weather at 14 pm
took to the SE at 3 pm squall from NW at 4 pm
cleared of rain the part fine weather off noon
ship to the NW but ten part heading the same
saw nothing so ended this day fine weather

Saturday January 23rd
this day began with fine weather at 9 pm
took to the SE mid afternoon fine weather
but ten part the same heading to the
NW one sail in sight so ended

Sunday January 24th
this day began with strong breezes
at 9 pm spoke the brig's pavilion of
Glorious Hole 24 m. ahead of 400 channels
around the mid afternoon strong wind
but ten part the same heading by the wind
to the NW at sun set sails so ended

Monday January 25th
this day began with strong breezes heading
to the NW mid afternoon to the SE at 6
light made sail heading to the NW
saw one sail so ended this day strong wind

Tuesday January 26th
this day began with strong breezes heading
to the NW at sun set took to the
SE mid afternoon strong breezes at day
light took to the NW saw nothing
so ended this day
