

Tuesday March Th 2. 1858
 this day began with fine breezy stein-
 ing or W at 5 pm saw Spanish whales
 loomed for them did not get fast they were
 bound south quick at dawn came on board
 steering N 40° at light saw Santa Cruz 12 miles
 dist at 5 saw St Thomas so ends this day

Wednesday March Th 3
 this day began with lite wind steering for
 St Thomas harbor at 6 pm came to anchor
 in the harbor mid day point fine weather took on
 board seven barrels of beef so ends this day

at St Thomas

Thursday March Th 4
 this day began with fine weather got red rays
 for all hands went on shore on liberty mid day
 point fine weather at 6 pm the crew came of all
 but two at 8 the capt went on shore so ends

at anchor

Friday March Th 5
 this day began with fine weather then
 capt on shore at 6 pm the came of ship were
 man mid day point strong wind with rain at 6
 at 6 got the other two men out of the port
 took the anchor came to sea steering S 54° W

so ends

Saturday March Th 6
 this day began with strong wind squally
 steering N 54° W mid day point fine weather
 at day light made sail steering W 60° on long
 the south side of port to Rico at 11 AM
 saw a hump back in shape of us steering
 in for him saw noth thing more of him then
 found 6 miles distance so ends this day

Sunday March Th 7 1858
 this day began with lite calm to sails in
 site mid day point lite and calm lost to point
 the same steering W to sails in site so ends this day

Monday March Th 8
 this day began with lite wind saw
 hump back loomed for them did not get
 on come on board cap of W strong breezes
 mid day point the same but ten point men mad
 note steering W 60° in play in reporing the
 Spanish so ends this day saw noth thing

Long 69° 16' W

Tuesday March Th 9
 this day began with brisk breezes stein-
 ing W the land in site one sail in site
 mid day point brisk breezes at day light made
 all sail wind S 54° the land in site so ends

Lat 17° 48' N

Wednesday March Th 10
 this day began with fine weather the day
 by the wind W 60° at 3 pm saw black fish
 loomed for them got noth thing touch to the 686
 the land 14 miles dist at mid night touch to the
 54° at 4 AM came on with rain at day light
 wind from N 40° steering W 54° at 10 closed
 eye saw 8 beata cap of for the rock after
 made lite wind calmer so ends land 8 miles

Thursday March Th 11
 this day began with moderate wind steering
 down for the rock at 4 pm past the rock
 Capt to the N at sea set short ten sail
 by a hook the day to the N at day light
 made sail the day in to the bay saw
 the Bank Lady Suffolk of Beverly
 Capt Robertson clear 24 month out
