

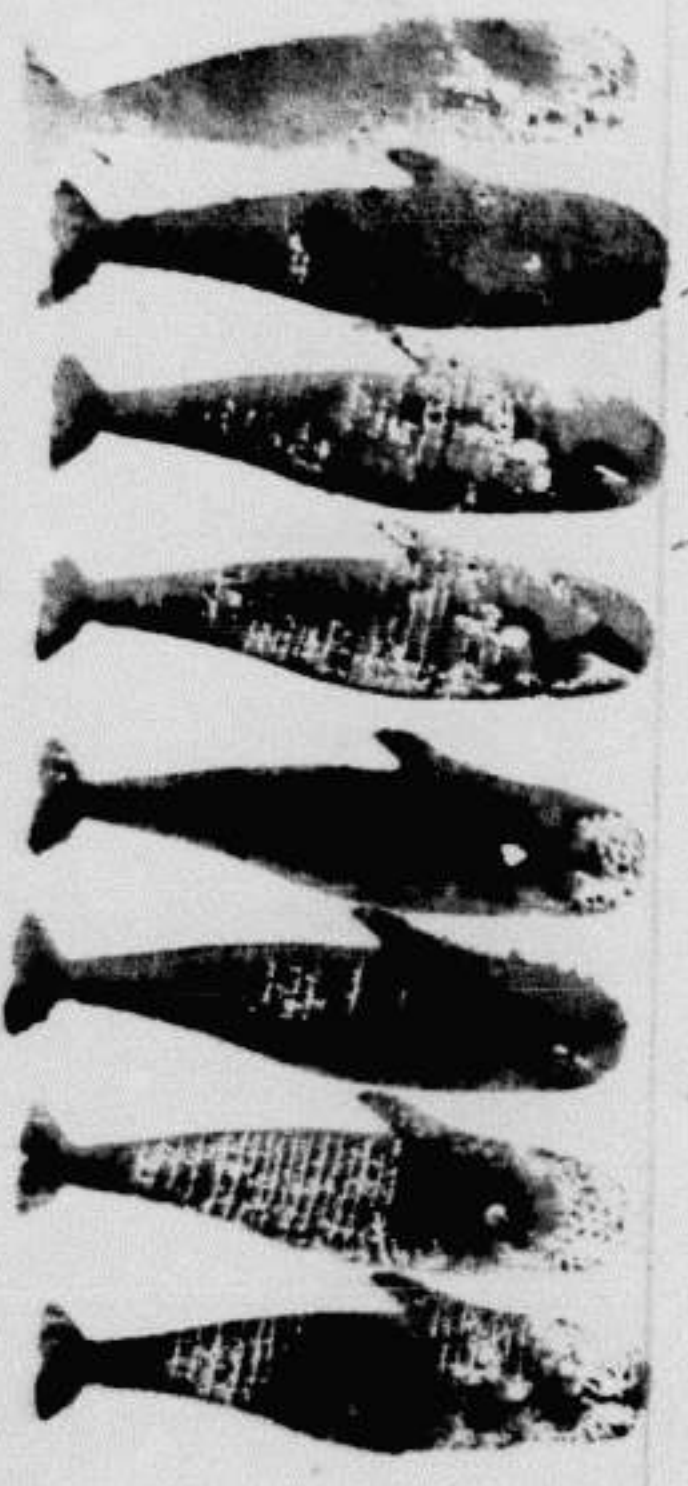
Saturday April ^{The} 10 1858

 this day begins with like wind from
 W at 2 pm the crew came down at
 4 pm had a squall of rain of the land
 at 5 pm cleared of like wind from the
 mid all part fine weather but ten part strong
 trade employed in boiling saw noth thing so bad

Wednesday April ^{The} 14
 this day begins with strong trade finished boiling
 at sun set shortened sail heading in shore mid
 all part fine weather at day light made
 sail heading in shore at 9 o'clock saw
 black fish bound for got noth thing
 so bad this day like wind calm



Thursday April ^{The} 15
 this day begins with like wind from the
 heading to the W. at sun set shortened
 sail by the wind to the S. S. W. mid all part
 like wind but ten part calm saw noth thing

Friday April ^{The} 16
 this day begins with wind from S. W.
 at 4 pm had a light squall of rain of the land
 steering W one sail in site to the W. at mid
 all part brisk breeze steering W. at day
 light headed in shore saw noth thing so bad

Saturday April ^{The} 17
 this day begins with like trade steering W.
 a long shore at sun set up of shore land 10
 miles dist mid all part calm but ten part like same
 steering W saw noth thing so bad this day

Sunday April ^{The} 18
 this day begins with like wind from the
 W a long shore the land 15 dist mid all part
 like wind at 3 o'clock left of shore like wind from
 the S. by small on but ten part the same

Monday April ^{The} 19
 this day begins with fine breeze steering
 W a long the land at 4 pm saw black fish
 bound for them got noth thing mid all part
 like wind but ten part the same of the last
 end of the is land so bad this day

Tuesday April ^{The} 20
 this day begins with like wind from south
 heading to the S. W a long the land mid all
 part the same at day light made all sail
 like wind heading to the S. W by small on
 the land 10 miles dist so bad this day
