Monday July 1	First Part finished cutting masts and Middle Part employed in boiling Latter Part strong trade employed in boiling Lat 5-37 S Long 107-40 W
Tuesday July 2	First Part of the 23 hours strong trade employed in boiling Middle Part finished boiling Latter Part strong winds employed in washing the ship Lat 5-25 S Long 107-30 W
Wednesday July 3	First Part strong trade up N by at sunset traded ship lie up S by Middle Part strong trade Latter Part strong winds under easy sail Lat 6-50 S Long 107 1/2 W
Thursday July 4	First Part strong winds saw 3 ships at sunset took in sail Middle Part lie up N by Latter Part strong trade set to main sail Lat Long

Friday July 5	First Part strong trade spoke the Skuas with 1600 lbs Middle Part fine weather Latter Part spoke the Bay of Agassiz 10 miles out 2000 Lat 5-34 S Long 107-50 W
Saturday July 6	First Part fine weather saw a school of whales, towed and struck 2 and got one back him along side Middle Part lie by the whale Latter Part employed in cutting Lat Long
Sunday July 7	First Part fine weather finished cutting began to boil Middle Part employed in boiling traded ship lie up N by Latter Part boiling Lat Long
Monday July 8	First Part pleasant lie up N by finished boiling Middle Part strong trade Latter Part pleasant lie up S by Lat 8-12 S Long 107-17 W
