(1841)
First Part strong trades and
clear weather lie up 1 PM
Middle Part strong
trades Later Part pleasant
saw 3 ships Lat 3-35 S
Long

Thursday
July 18th
(1841)
First Part strong trades and
pleasant lie up N. at 1 PM
saw whales towards and got
one took him alongside
Middle Part lie
by the whale Later Part
employed in cutting the whale
Lat 4-15 S
Long

Friday
July 19th
(1841)
First Part strong trades
finished cutting began to boil
Middle Part employed
in boiling lie up N. at
Later Part strong
trades employed in boiling
Lat 4-35 S
Long 109-22 W

Saturday
July 20th
(1841)
First Part strong winds and
saw sail Middle Part
finished boiling
Later Part
strong trades lie up N. at
Lat 3-22 S
Long

July 21st
(1841)
First Part strong trades lie up
Still saw 2 ships steering
to the N. Middle Part strong
trades Later Part more
moderate made some sail
lie up 1 PM Lat 3-00 S
Long

Monday
July 22nd
(1841)
First Part strong trades
sail lie up 1 PM Middle Part
Later Part strong trades
squally weather lie up 1 PM
Lat 4-00 S
Long 109-42 W

Tuesday
July 23rd
(1841)
First Part moderate breezes
lie up N. by N Middle Part
squally weather Later Part
pleasant weather took ship
made some sail
Lat 4-00 S
Long

Wednesday
July 24th
(1841)
First Part strong trades
& starchy weather Middle Part the
same Later Part
saw a shoal of whales
saw one but did not
catch them at 10 PM when
the 2 Ocean 12 miles out
saw 600 Lat 3-00 S
