 Latter Part pleasant under all sail
 Lat 4-57 N Long

Monday Aug 5th 1850
 First Part pleasant at 10 PM saw a schooner ap proach lowered and got 1 foot him alongside & cut him in at 6 PM spoke the Almas 1700 lbs
 Middle Part pleasant Latter Part boiling
 Lat 4-55 N

 First Part fine pleasant weather under all sail tie up
 Latter Part employed in boiling Middle Part touching ship tie up
 Latter Part pleasant under all sail finished boiling
 Lat 5-25 S Long 112-50 W

Wednesday Aug 7th 1850
 First Part fine pleasant weather touched ship tie up
 Latter Part saw 2 ships Middle Part pleasant under all sail
 Latter Part light breezes employed in ships duty
 Lat 6-05 S Long 111-25 W

Thursday Aug 8th 1850
 First Part fine pleasant under all sail tie up
 Middle Part pleasant Latter Part fine weather saw a sail to windward
 Lat 6-12 S Long 110-31 W

Friday Aug 9th 1850
 First Part fine pleasant weather under all sail tie up
 Latter Part 5 PM touched ship tie up
 Latter Part employed in ships duty
 Lat 6-40 S Long 110-26 W
