Saturday Aug 10th 1833
 First Part light breeze
 pleasant under all sail in
 up N.E. by E
 Middle Part
 pleasant Latter Part light
 N.E. at noon took ship
 in up S.W. Lat 4-00 S
 Long

Sunday Aug 11th 1833
 First Part light breeze in
 up S.W. employed in stowing
 down in the between decks
 Middle Part pleasant
 Latter Part strong trades
 under all sail
 Lat 5-09 S
 Long 110-30 W

Monday Aug 12th 1833
 First Part of this 24 hours
 fine breeze from the S.W.
 in up S.W. at 5 P.M. took
 ship in up N.E.
 Middle Part
 strong trades caught a porpoise
 Latter Part strong
 trades employed in setting up
 the main rigging
 Lat 5

Tuesday Aug 13th 1833
 First Part pleasant in
 up N.E. Middle Part
 took ship Latter Part
 fine weather
 Lat 5-40 S

Wednesday Aug 14th 1833
 First Part of this 24 hours fine
 pleasant weather saw a number
 of sperm whales lowered and
 got one took him alongside
 and cut him in
 Middle Part light
 breeze Latter Part began
 to hoist
 Lat 5-40 S
 Long

Thursday Aug 15th 1833
 First Part fine weather in
 N.E. employed in hoisting
 Middle Part
 caught a porpoise employed
 in hoisting Latter Part
 finished hoisting Lat 4-55 S
 Long 111-04 W

Friday Aug 16th 1833
 First fine pleasant weather
 saw a number of fin backs
 at 5 P.M. spoke the Steamer
 & whaler Seneca we saw her
 last Middle Part
 light breeze in up N.E.
 Latter Part took
 ship in up S.W. Lat 4-49 S

Saturday Aug 17th 1833
 First Part pleasant at 4 P.M.
 saw a whale lowered and got
 one of them Middle Part
 in by the whale Latter Part
 employed in
 cutting the whale
 E.B. 70 lbs
