Latter Part fine
weather employed in boiling
Lat 4-39 S
Long

Wednesday
Aug 21st
1855

First Part light breeze
employed in boiling
Middle Part
boiling Latter Part
finished boiling washed up
the deck
Lat 4-30 S

Aug 26th
1855
First Part strong trade and clear
under easy sail tie up fly off
Middle Part much the
same Latter Part strong
trade at 6 AM saw a sail to
windward Lat 4-56 S
Long

Tuesday
Aug 27th
1855

First Part strong trade under
short sail tie up fly off
Middle Part strong
winds and squally took in the
main sail Latter Part squally
weather saw a sail to windward
Lat 4-50 S
Long

Wednesday
Aug 28th
1855

First Part of this 24 hours strong
winds and squally abate night
the top sails at 2 PM saw a
sail to windward Middle Part strong
winds Latter Part much
same sail Lat 4-39 S
Long

Thursday
Aug 29th
1855

First Part strong trade
employed in various gales of ship
duty Middle Part squally
weather tie up fly off
Latter Part strong
winds and squally
Lat 4-56 S
