 First Part strong trades and
 pleasant in up 8 1/2 PM
 Middle Part strong
 trades Later Part light
 breeze in up AM saw a ship
 to board Lat 5-04 S
 Long

Sunday Aug 1st
 First Part fine weather in
 AM made sail employed
 in ship duty Middle Part
 took ship in up 8 1/2 PM
 Later Part fine
 breeze from the SE in up
 8 1/2 PM Lat 4-09 S
 Long 110-56 W

Monday Sept 2 1832
 First Part fine pleasant
 weather in up 8 1/2 PM
 Middle Part strong
 trades Later Part saw
 a shoal of whales however
 but did not catch them
 Lat 6-03 S
 Long 111-40 W

 strong trades and squally weather
 Lat 2-59 S

 squally took in the main sail
 in up AM Middle Part
 squally double reefed the topsails
 took in the jib Later Part more
 moderate made some sail
 took ship in up 8 1/2 PM
 Lat 4-41 S
 Long

Thursday Sept 7 1833
 First Part strong winds
 and squally in up 8 1/2 PM
 took in some sail Middle Part squally
 took ship in up AM
 Later Part strong
 winds and rough weather
 Lat 4-31 S

Friday Sept 8 1833
 First Part strong trades in
 up AM employed in ship
 duty Middle Part
 squally Later Part
 strong winds in up AM
 Lat 5-49 S
 Long 109-57 W
