(1833)
First Part strong trade from the S by E at sunset took in some sail Middle Part strong winds Latter Part more moderate made some sail lie up E by S Lat 4-56 S Long 110-13 W

Sunday
Sept 5th
(1833)
First Part strong winds & rough weather lie up E by S Middle Part squally weather Latter Part lie up Lat 5-18 S Long 110-00 W

Monday
Sept 6th
(1833)
First Part strong trade lie up E by S at sunset took ship took in the main sail Middle Part strong trade and squally lie up S Latter Part much the same employed in ships duty Lat 6-12 S Long

Tuesday
Sept 7th
(1833)
First Part strong winds lie up S by E took in the fore Middle Part strong winds Latter Part the same lie up S by E Lat 6-18 S Long

Sept 8th
(1833)
First Part strong trade and clear lie up S by E employed in ships duty Middle Part strong trade Latter Part more moderate made sail lie up S by E No sails to day

Thursday
Sept 9th
(1833)
First Part fine pleasant weather lie up S by E employed in breaking out 48 Middle Part took ship lie up E by S Latter Part fine weather under all sail took ship lie up E by S Lat 6-12 S Long

Friday
Sept 10th
(1833)
First Part fine pleasant weather under all sail lie up E by E employed in ships duty Middle Part much the same Latter Part pleasant under all sail Lat 6-18 S

Saturday
Sept 11th
(1833)
First Part pleasant breeze from the S by E lie up E by E Middle Part took ship lie up S by E Latter Part fine weather employed in ships duty Lat
