Wednesday Oct 9th
First Part pleasant took the whale alongside and cut in the body Middle Part equally by the head Latter Part finished cutting began to hit Lat 2-42-5 Long 109-21 W

Thursday Oct 10th
First Part of this 24 hours fine pleasant weather employed in boiling made sail lie up till at 6 PM tacked ship lie up at Middle Part employed in boiling Latter Part fine weather employed in boiling Lat 5-10-5 Long

Friday Oct 11th
First Part light breezes and pleasant lie up till at 2 PM tacked ship lie up at Middle Part employed in boiling Middle Part finished boiling Latter Part made some sail lie up till at 6 PM Lat 4-20-5

Saturday Oct 12th
First Part fine pleasant weather lie up till at sunset took in sail tacked ship lie up till at Middle Part equally Latter Part pleasant

First Part light breezes steering ship employed in various parts of ship duty at sunset took in sail Middle Part light breezes Latter Part pleasant made all sail Lat 2-42-5 Long 87-26 W

Friday Oct 10th
First Part light breezes steering ship employed in ships duty at sunset took in the light sails Middle Part light breezes Latter Part pleasant made all sail Lat 9-24-5 Long

Saturday Oct 11th
First Part light breezes under all sail steering ship at sunset tacked ship Middle Part light breezes lie up till at 6 PM Latter Part made all sail lie up till at 6 PM Lat 8-34-5 Long 87-26 W

Sunday Oct 12th
First Part strong trade breeze employed in ships duty at sunset took in the light sails Middle Part light breezes Latter Part made sail lie up till at 6 PM Lat 4-20-5 Long
