First Part light breezes and pleasant weather. At sunset shortened sail. Middle Part light breezes. Latter Part made sail lie up & we saw more black fish however and caught 7

1834
First Part strong trades and pleasant weather. At sunset took in sail. Middle Part light breezes. Latter Part pleasant weather. In evening the black fish

Friday
Jan 24th
1834
First Part light breezes and pleasant weather. In various parts of ship duty. Middle Part light breezes. Latter Part pleasant weather. Under all sail lie up & we
Lat 6-00 S

Saturday
Jan 25th
1834
First Part light breezes and pleasant weather. Under all sail. Middle Part saw the land distant about 4 leagues. Latter Part kept up N by E

Henry Cruising on *Pera* 1834

Monday
Jan 26th
1834
First Part light breezes steering N by E. At 11 AM a breeze standing in shore. Point of Hughah bearing N by E at 2 PM. In PM the head bearing N distant about 6 leagues at sunset shortened sail. Left to with the main sail aback. Middle Part light breezes. Latter Part pleasant weather. One boat on shore. Pata head. Point of Hughah Bay

Tuesday
Jan 27th
1834
First Part strong trades by afternoon at 8 PM boat came up made sail steering N by E. Middle Part light breezes. Latter Part pleasant weather. An English Brig hauled up Pata

Long 82-35 W

Jan 28th
1834
First Part light breezes and pleasant weather. Under all sail steering N by E. In ship duty. Middle Part light breezes. Steering N by E. Latter Part pleasant weather. Under all sail. In various parts of ship duty
