

Remarks on Board Ship Charles

Wednesday Jan 29 1834
First Part of this 24 hours fine pleasant weather under all sail steering N by E Middle Part light breeze Latter Part fine weather saw a ship on the larboard side steering to the W Lat 5-30 S Long 86-02.

Thursday Jan 30 1834
First Part light breeze and pleasant steering N by E in mending main top sail Middle Part light breezes Latter Part pleasant employed in ships work Lat 2-56 S Long 87-40 W

Friday Jan 31 1834
First Part light breezes under all sail steering N by E nothing worthy of note occurred Middle Part light airs Latter Part sailing under all sail with rain Lat 1-00 S Long 89-00 W

Saturday Feb 1 1834
First Part light airs under all sail at 2 PM saw Hood's Island distant about 5 leagues Middle Part light and airy Latter Part came to anchor in 10 fathoms water

Monday Feb 2 1834
First Part pleasant one boat on shore cut 2 turpins Middle Part rain Latter Part 3 boats on shore after turpin and chalk some up with a few more

Tuesday Feb 3 1834
First Part light rain and rain Middle Part the same Latter Part 4 boats on shore after turpin

Wednesday Feb 4 1834
First Part rain at 4 PM boats came on board with 25 turpins Middle Part rain Latter Part all hands after turpin again

Thursday Feb 5 1834
First Part rain weather at 4 PM boats came up with 32 fine large pelicans Middle Part rain Latter Part 2 boats on shore after wood

Friday Feb 6 1834
First Part 4 boats on board and upped Middle Part 2 boats on board Latter Part employed in getting up wood and some water
