Henry Bound of Shore 1834

Friday
Feb 14th
1834
First Part pleasant employment
roasting oil and breaking out in
pore hold at sunset took in
Middle Part sailing Latter Part
employment in stowing down in the
pore hold Lat 3-12 S

Saturday
Feb 15th
1834
First Part pleasant finished
stowing down in the pore hold
Middle Part pleasant keep
off ship Latter Part commenced
breaking out to roast the oil
Lat 3-30 S

Sunday
Feb 16th
1834
First Part pleasant employment in
roasting and stowing down
Middle Part squally lie up
Latter Part roasting oil
Lat 4-12 S

Monday
Feb 17th
1834
First Part fine weather lie up
off ship finished the Harbour
side of the main hold
Middle Part strong trades
Latter Part began on the S
side Lat

Tuesday
Feb 18th
1834
First Part strong trades lie up
employment in roasting and stowing
down Middle Part squally
lie up off ship Latter Part
more ship to the S Lat 3-58 S

Wednesday
Feb 19th
1834
First Part pleasant finished breaking
out the oil Middle Part lie up
off ship Latter Part employment in roasting
oil and stowing down at 8 AM
off ship Lat 4-34 S

Thursday
Feb 20th
1834
First Part fine pleasant weather
employment at 4 PM finished roasting
oil and stowing down the oil washed
up the decks Middle Part
made some sail steering N by S
Latter Part pleasant made all sail
employment in ship's duty Lat 5-06 S

Friday
Feb 21st
1834
First Part pleasant under all sail
steering N by S employment in various
ship's duty Middle Part
pleasant Latter Part saw 2 ships
ahead Lat 5-49 S
Long 95-49 W

Saturday
Feb 22nd
1834
First Part at 10 AM first observation
saw a school of whales 10 were
struck 3 but saw one at 6 PM
took him along side and cut him
in Middle Part took to the
oil Latter Part began to boil
one ship in sight Lat 5-30 S
Long 95-36 W
