1833  
First Part strong trader laid up  
by the emplace in boiling  
Middle Part back ship laid up  
Later Part at 8 PM  
finished boiling kept up till 10 PM  
Left 05 02 S

Feb 24<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part strong trader laid up  
at 3 PM saw a school of min  
some but did not catch them  
name on board sent a ship to work  
ward at 8 PM spoke the George  
of W. B. Capt. 14 miles out  
Middle Part took  
ship in up till Later Part  
pleasant George in sight

Feb 24<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part pleasant breezes under  
all sail emplace in various J  
of ships duty  
Middle Part up  
Later Part light air on the  
the fly till to mence  
Left 5-01 S  
Long 99-45

Feb 26<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part went the fly J  
and slowed down 20 mls ap  
in the main hold  
Middle Part took ship to  
No Later Part light breeze  
Left 1-44 S

First Part strong trader at sunset  
took in the top gallant sail & reeft to  
top sail Middle Part up  
Later Part made sail lie up till  
at 11 PM saw a school of whales

Feb 25<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part strong trader toward  
chase but could not catch them  
Middle Part rained under way  
Later Part made sail for  
up till employed in mending a boat  
Left 4-54 S

Saturday  
Feb 26<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part strong trader saw a  
school of whales toward and struck  
March 3 and surge & took them at a side  
Middle Part by the whales  
Later Part out them in  
Left  
DBB 25 116  
LB 12 116

Sunday  
Feb 27<sup>th</sup>  
1833  
First Part at 3 PM began to boil  
lie up till Middle Part rained part  
March out the fire at 4 PM in company  
got again Later Part  
strong trader got the fore &  
mizzen top sail lie up till  
Left 5-49 S  
Long 101-38 W
