Monday
March 3
1833
First Part strong trade finish
boiling washed up the cheeks at
4 PM saw breakers to windward
Middle Part tacked
lie up at 6 Later Part employed
in ship duty made some sail
Lat 4-45 S

Tuesday
March 4
1833
First Part light trade turned
one reef out of the fore & main
top sail set the main sail
Middle Part squally weather
the top sail and furlled the
sail Later Part employed in
ship duty Lat 4-54 S
Long

Wednesday
March 5
1833
First Part strong trade lie
up at sunset shortened sail
lie up at 6 Middle Part
squally weather Later Part
made sail tacked ship lie up at 8
employed in mending sails
Lat

Thursday
March 6
1833
First Part strong trade employed
in mending sails at sunset
shortened sail tacked ship
lie up at 6 Middle Part
squally Later Part strong
trade Lat
Long

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Friday
March 7
1833
First Part strong trade mending
weather at 7 PM tacked ship lie
up at sunset shortened sail
Middle Part strong
trade Later Part squally double
reef the fore top sail
Lat 4-55 S
Long 105-26 W

Saturday
March 8
1833
First Part strong trade from
the S & lie up at sunset tacked
in sail Middle Part strong
trade Later Part strong trade
tacked ship lie up at 6 set
the fore employed in mending
sails Lat 4-52 S
Long 105-34 W

Sunday
March 9
1833
First Part strong trade lie up
at 6 employed in stowing
downy some oil between
cheeks and getting up water
at sunset took in the fore
Middle Part
light breeze lie up at 6
Later Part made some sail
lie up at 6 at 11 PM
saw a sail ahead standing
to the left Lat 4-44 S
