

Remarks on Board Ship Charles or Offering Cruising of Shore

Monday
March 10th
1834
First Part strong trade sea up
6 PM set the main sail at 2
PM spoke the ship at 10 PM
120 that sunset took in the
main sail tacked ship lie up
Latter Part pleasant
trades employed in mending
main sail saw a sail to wind
ward Lat 5-45 S

Tuesday
March 11th
1834
First Part pleasant at 5 PM
bent the main sail at sunset
shortened sail Middle Part
raining tacked ship lie up 6 PM
Latter Part bent the
main topsail to mend
Lat 5-15 S

Wednesday
March 12th
1834
First Part pleasant at 2 PM
saw a sail to windward at
5 PM bent the main topsail
saw a sail to windward
Middle Part raining
Latter Part made all sail 2
ships in sight at 10 PM tacked
ship lie up 11 PM
Lat 5-48 S
Long 105-00 W

Thursday
March 13th
1834
First Part fine pleasant weather
under all sail at 4 PM
the ship tacked at 11 PM 24 PM
out 1700 lbs Capt. Clarke
Middle Part pleasant
Latter Part bent the fore sail
to mend Lat 5-48 S
Long

Friday
March 14th
1834
First Part pleasant breezes from
the S at 5 PM bent the fore sail
at 7 tacked ship lie up 9 PM
Middle Part light
breezes Latter Part pleasant
employed in blacking the chain
cable saw a sail to windward
Lat

Saturday
March 15th
1834
First Part fine pleasant
weather under all sail lie up
at sunset took in the light
sails Middle Part squally
Latter Part spoke the ship
Capt. Dickell 4 miles out 90 lbs
Lat

Sunday
March 16th
1834
First Part strong trades sea up
6 PM under easy sail
Middle Part tacked
ship lie up 11 PM
Latter Part pleasant
weather lie up 11 PM
Lat 5-42 S
