

Remarks on Board Ship *Chambers* Henry Cruising of Shore 1834

Monday
March 17th
1834
First Part strong tracks from the S. by E. up to the N. nothing worth of note occurred. Middle Part Strong tracks. Latter Part made sail on board the ship to mend. Left 5-50 P. Long 109-50

Tuesday
March 18th
1834
First Part strong tracks lying S. by E. bent the mizzen topmast gain track ship lie up to the N. at sunset took in the light sails. Middle Part lie up. Latter Part made all sail lie up. Left 5-57 P. Long 109-10

Wednesday
March 19th
1834
First Part strong tracks lying S. by E. employed in ship duty at sunset shortened sail. Middle Part fine weather. Latter Part made sail to up. S. by E. employed in ship duty. Left 4-52 P. Long

fine weather and no Whales to be seen

Thursday
March 20th
1834
First Part strong tracks lying S. by E. at sunset took in sail. Middle Part strong tracks lying S. by E. Latter Part kept up. Latter Part made sail attached with some rain. Left. Long

Friday
March 21st
1834
First Part strong tracks steering S. by E. at sunset shortened sail to the S. by E. Middle Part light breeze. Latter Part made sail at 6 PM saw a school of whales going to windward. Left 4-54 P. Long 191 15 W

Saturday
March 22nd
1834
First Part fine pleasant weather at sunset took in sail. Middle Part light breeze. Latter Part saw a school of whales toward and in lost him by taking the line 2 ships in sight. Left. Long

Sunday
March 23rd
1834
First Part strong tracks and equally to the S. by E. at sunset took in sail. Middle Part the same weather. Latter Part sailing. Left. Long
