April 19
1834
First Part at 2 PM took a strong
trache from the ENE steering N. by
E. took in the fore and mizen
top gallant sail & by 5 PM lower steering
sail & main royal
Middle Part
took in the fore top mast standing and
single reef the top sails
Latter Part strong trache
took in the mainsail
Lat 09-15 N
Long 134-05 W

Sunday
April 20
1834
First Part strong trache from the
trache steering N. by E. set the main
sail Middle Part
set the main top gallant sail
Latter Part strong trache
nothing worthy of note occurred
Lat 11-45 N
Long 131-45 W

Monday
April 21
1834
First Part at this 24 hours
strong trache from the N. by
steering N. by E. took in the
main top gallant sail
Middle Part
strong trache Latter Part
set the main top gallant sail
steering N. by E.
Lat 13-35 N
Long 134-16 W

Henry Bound to the Sandwich

Sunday
April 22
1834
First Part strong trache and steady
weather steering N. by E. at 6 PM
took in the main top gallant sail
Middle Part set it
Latter Part strong wind
took in the main top gallant sail and
mainsail & double reef the top sails
Lat 14-59 N
Long 134-05 W

Wednesday
April 23
1834
First Part strong trache from the
N. by steering N. by E.
Middle Part
set the fore and main top gallant sail
and mainsail Latter Part set the
fore top mast luff sail
Lat 16-10 N
Long 139-38 W

Thursday
April 24
1834
First Part strong trache from the N. by
steering N. by E. Middle Part equally
Latter Part took in and made sail
circumlingly
Lat 17-45 N
Long 142-45 W

Friday
April 25
1834
First Part strong trache steering
N. by E. took in the fore top gallant sail
made it and kept adding
Middle Part strong
Latter Part made all sail
set the lower and main top gallant
sails in main royal
Lat 19-06 Long 145-09 W
