Saturday
April
27
1834
First Part of this 24 hours commenced strong trade and pleasant weather under all sail steering W by N employed in manœuvring the ship and meeting the Middle Port
Strong trade all night
Later Part fine weather with light squalls of rain employed in getting up shoots for water
Lat 20 - 02 W
Long 148 - 02 W

Sunday
April
28
1834
First Part fine pleasant weather under all sail steering W by N employed in various jobs of ship's duty
Middle Port strong trade all sail duty
Later Part pleasant breeze nothing north of note occurred
Lat 20 - 12 N
Long 151 - 13 W

Monday
April
29
1834
First Part of this 24 hours fine breeze and pleasant weather under all sail steering W
Middle Port squally took in the main reef
steering W
Later Part light breeze and squally weather employed in various duties of ship's duty
Lat 20 - 09 N
Long 154 - 00 W

April
30
1834
First Part strong trade and pleasant weather under all sail steering W by N
Middle Port light breeze
steering W
Later Part at 4 PM saw the island of Ohowe bearing S by distant about 6 leagues at 9 PM saw Moritoe bearing W at 12 saw Rai bearing S by

Wednesday
April
30
1834
First Part strong trade steering in here took in the steering sails at 2 PM saw Moritoe at 3 came to anchor in Lapina roads
Middle Port light breeze later part employed in getting up water
