 First Part strong gale from the S. E. at 1 P.M. nothing was taken in sail. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part made sail lie up at 4 P.M. Lt 162-10 C

Saturday June 28 1833
 First Part of the 24 hours strong gale from the S. E. at 1 P.M. at sunset reefed the topsails. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part made some sail lie up at 4 P.M. Lt 29-40 M Lt 161-05 C

Sunday June 29 1833
 First Part fine pleasant weather lie up at 1 P.M. employed in ship's duty at sunset shortened sail. Middle Part moderate wind. Latter Part saw sperm whales lowered but did not catch them Lt 29-35 M Lt Long

Monday June 30 1833
 First Part strong wind from the S. E. at 1 P.M. at 6 P.M. saw a whale to windward at sunset took in sail. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part made sail lie up at 4 P.M. Lt 30-10 M Lt Long
