July 27th
1871
First Part of this 24 hours strong wind from the E. by N. lie up & spoke the Province of Montreal. Left Sagadahoc 26 Mths out 15th hls at sunset shortened sail. Middle Part lie up. N. Latter Part made some steering N.W. by W.
Set 32 to N.
July 151-24th

Monday
July 28th
1871
First Part fine pleasant weather steering N.W. at 6 P.M. spoke Kingston. Left Sherman 21 Mths out 400 hls at sunset took in the topsails. Middle Part squally. Latter Part strong wind made some sail employed in sailing in the flying jib. Set

Tuesday
July 29th
1871
First Part strong gales from the E. by N. lie up & at sunset shortened sail. Middle Part strong gales. Latter Part made some sail lie up & set 2 ships to windward.
Set 30-29 N.
July

Wednesday
July 30th
1871
First Part strong wind from the E. by N. lie up & at sunset took in sail. Middle Part strong wind lie up. Latter Part made some sail saw 2 ships.
Set 29-15 N.
July 151-24th

Thursday
July 31st
1871
First Part strong gales from the E. by N. lie up & bent the main stay sail. Middle Part strong gales. Latter Part strong wind lie up & bent the main stay sail.
Set 27-22 N.
July

Friday
Aug 1st
1871
First Part strong wind from the E. by N. lie up & at sunset took in sail and took ship lie up N.W. Middle Part lie up N.W. Latter Part made some sail.
Set 28-22 N.
July

Saturday
Aug 2nd
1871
First Part strong wind from the E. by N. lie up & bent the main stay sail and bent another at sunset shortened sail. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part made sail lie up & set 2 ships to windward.
