Sunday Aug 17 1834	First Part light breeze and Pleasant took ship lie up N at sunset took in the light sail. Middle Part light air. Latter Part calm Lay 184 30 E
Monday Aug 18 1834	First Part of this 24 hours Pleasant and calm. Latter Part calm Latter Part light air and lighting weather. Latter Part Lay 184 30 E
