Richmond Sept 3rd 1834
 First Part of this 24 hours strong gale from the E by N. M. P. anchored at anchor and bent the mast in at sunset took in sail. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part strong wind some sail. Lat 30-31 N.

Sunday Sept 4th 1834
 First Part strong wind from the E by N. M. P. employed in ship duty at sunset took in topsails. Middle Part strong wind. Latter Part made some sail. Lat 31-31 N. Long 157-196

Monday Sept 5th 1834
 First Part strong wind from the E by N. M. P. at sunset took in sail. Middle Part light breeze. Latter Part saw a whale and got one took him aboard. Lat 31-31 N. Long 157-196

Tuesday Sept 6th 1834
 First Part finished cutting. Latter Part strong wind in boiling. Lat 30-31 N.

Wednesday Sept 7th 1834
 First Part strong gale. Latter Part finished boiling at sunset took in the foresail. Middle Part strong gale and squally. Latter Part set the fore topsail to foresail. Lat 30-30 N. Long 156-278

Thursday Sept 8th 1834
 First Part of this 24 hours strong gale from the E by N. Latter Part set short board sail. Middle Part tight breeze. Latter Part pleasant made sail. Lat 30-31 N.

Friday Sept 9th 1834
 First Part tight breeze from the E by N. Latter Part employed in ship duty sent down the mizzen topgallant yard at sunset took in sail. Middle Part tight breeze. Latter Part pleasant made all sail. Lat 30-31 N.
